## A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF LARCHMONT REGARDING THE COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE OF PRIVATE DWELLINGS

Section One. § 241-14 B.(1) of the Code of the Village of Larchmont is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

(1) Municipally collected solid waste of private dwellings shall be placed immediately adjacent to the curb in front of the residence. It shall be placed to the house side of the curb, not in the street. If there is no curb, it shall be placed on the edge of the property adjacent to the paved area of the street, but not in the street. The municipally collected solid waste shall not be placed out in plastic bags. The municipally collected solid waste set out for collection shall be placed in plastic containers sufficient in number and capacity to store the municipally collected solid waste subject to limitations prescribed in this law. Municipally collected solid waste shall be set out for collection no earlier than dusk of the day before a scheduled collection day and no later than 7:00 am (prevailing time) on a scheduled day for collection.

Section Two. § 241-23 of the Code of the Village of Larchmont is hereby amended by repealing § 241-23.B thereof and adding thereto a new § 241-23.B and a new § 241-23.C to read as follows:

§ 241-23.B. The owner or occupier of a private dwelling occupied solely by senior citizens age seventy (70) or above may apply for special refuse services. Special refuse services shall mean an exemption from the requirement for setting out solid waste at the curb. If granted an exemption, the owner or occupier of the private dwelling may place their solid waste at the side or the rear of the private dwelling at a location to be approved by the Superintendent of the Larchmont Mamaroneck Joint Garbage Disposal Commission. Owners or occupiers of private dwellings that believe they are eligible for an exemption shall file an application on the form established by the Commission. The application shall be filed with the Superintendent of the Commission and the applicant shall be notified of the decision in writing or by e-mail no more than thirty (30) days after the date the application is received by the Commission. The exemption from curbside garbage collection shall be renewed every two (2) years to ensure the accuracy of the program.

§ 241-23.C. Relief hereunder shall be granted upon such terms and conditions as the Board or Commission may consider just.

Section Three. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
